Station Information at a glance

Union Station

- Connecting light rail lines: E, C, W; B & G commuter rail (coming later 2016)
- Connecting bus routes: Free MallRide, Free Metro Ride, local and regional bus service out of Union Station
- The University of Colorado A Line will stop at Platform 1 at Union Station. This is the closest track to the historic building and the Union Station Pavilion, which provides access to the underground bus concourse.

38th • Blake

- Address: 3737 Blake St., Denver
- Parking: 200
- Connecting bus routes: 12, 44

40th • Colorado

- Address: 4220 Garfield St., Denver
- Parking: 200
- Connecting bus routes: 24, 37, 40, 44

Central Park

- This Park-n-Ride is accessible from I-70 via the Central Park Boulevard interchange.
- Address: 8175 E. Smith Road, Denver
- Parking: 1,500
- Connecting bus routes: 28, 34, 37, 42, 43, 65, 73, 88, 89, 105

Peoria

- This station is shared with the northern end-of-line station for the R Line (opening late 2016) and will provide connections to light rail.
- Address: 11501 E. 33rd Ave., Aurora
- Parking: 550
- Connecting rail lines: R Line (late 2016)
- Connecting bus routes: 37, 45, 121, 153

40th Ave & Airport Blvd • Gateway Park

- This existing RTD Park-n-Ride will serve as a commuter rail station.
- Address: 3900 North Salda Street, Aurora
- Parking: 1,079
- Connecting bus routes: 37, 42, 45, 121, 169

61st & Peña

- Address: 6045 N. Richfield St., Denver
- Parking: 800 (private lot subject to different fees)

Denver Airport Station

- The eastern end-of-line station provides direct access to airline check-in, baggage check, and security screening.
- Parking: No RTD parking. Airport lots only.
- Connecting bus routes: AA, AB, AT, 145X, and 169L

Fare information

Travel on the University of Colorado A Line will depend on your destination:

Local fare:	\$2.60 / *\$1.30	Travel between 1-2 zones
Regional fare:	\$4.50 / *\$2.25	Travel between 3 zones
Airport fare:	\$9.00 / *\$4.50	Trips starting or ending at Denver International Airport

*Discount fares apply to seniors 65+, individuals with disabilities, Medicare recipients, and elementary, middle and high school students, ages 6-19. Provide proof of eligibility when boarding. Seniors and individuals with disabilities may obtain a Special Discount Card by calling 303.299.2667

Parking at rail stations

Parking fees in RTD Park-n-Rides depend on if your car is registered within the RTD service area. Check at www.rtd-denver.com/howtopark.

Parking is free for the first 24 hours if your vehicle is registered within our service area. After 24 hours, a \$2.00 daily fee applies. If you live out of district, a \$4.00 daily fee applies. You must always pay before leaving your vehicle.

Buy tickets

You can buy tickets for the University of Colorado A Line at the ticket vending machines located at any rail station with cash or credit card.

You may also buy a variety of fare products at any RTD sales outlet or online. Participating King Soopers and Safeway stores sell ticket books and monthly passes.

Be safe around buses and trains

- Stand behind the yellow warning stripes at the station.
- Look both ways before you cross the tracks at the stations and at road; obey all warning signs and signals at the stations and crossings.
- Trains are very fast and can't stop quickly. Never try to beat a train across the tracks.
- Remove headphones when you are around buses and trains and pay attention.
